What is Kiwisport

The Kiwisport Regional Partnership fund is a government funded initiative that helps to get more school- aged children participating in organised sport. Sport NZ who oversee the KiwiSport fund have enlisted the 14 Regional Sports Trusts, such as Sport Waikato, to manage the fund on their behalf. The amount of funding allocated to each Sports Trust depends on how many school aged children are in each region. Sport Waikato has administered this fund on behalf of Sport NZ since 2009.

The Kick Start Fund is exactly that, a fund that will help Kick Start new sporting opportunity for school age students.

- Funding will be allocated on a range of projects to ensure region wide coverage
- Six funding rounds per year (maximum 12 month period for each project)
- The maximum allocation to be \$5000 per project

For examples of successful projects, refer to the Funded Projects tab on the right.

It is highly recommended applicants consider the following criteria before submitting their application:

- A minimum contribution of 25% in cash of in kind towards the total project costs
- The project is not a retrospective project
- The application is NOT just for the equipment with no project outcomes
- Creating links with local clubs and schools
- Reporting requirements as specified below
- Project is supported by the relevant Regional or National Sport Organisation

Reporting Requirements

A report is required to be completed on the outcomes of the project. Templates will be provided where appropriate.

These include a summary of the impact and overall numbers as a result of the project.

A financial breakdown on what cost were associated with the project is also required.

These reports are due 2 weeks after the completion of the project.
