Andrew Jones is an expert in learning design and teacher professional development. He is in the throes of finalising his PhD at the University of Melbourne in the area of School Learning Culture and Teacher Learning under the expert tutelage of Professor John Hattie. Andrew has been working in schools in a range of school settings both as a teacher, school leader and leadership coach



for 25 years now. He led the closure and regeneration of four failing schools in the northern suburbs of Melbourne and he has a Master's in Educational Leadership. Andrew consults regularly with practitioners, researchers and policy makers across Australia and has works in New Zealand, the Pacific Islands, Europe and in the United States. He is currently working with DET Professional Practice and Leadership Division on an international project into teacher-level leadership. His work with the coaching department of the Melbourne Football Club and St Kilda Football Club over the past 4 years, his role as Principal as Residence in the Australian Research Council's Science of Learning Research Centre (University of Melbourne) and as education advisor at Smiling Mind, have all helped to create a highly unique skillet relevant for many contexts.
