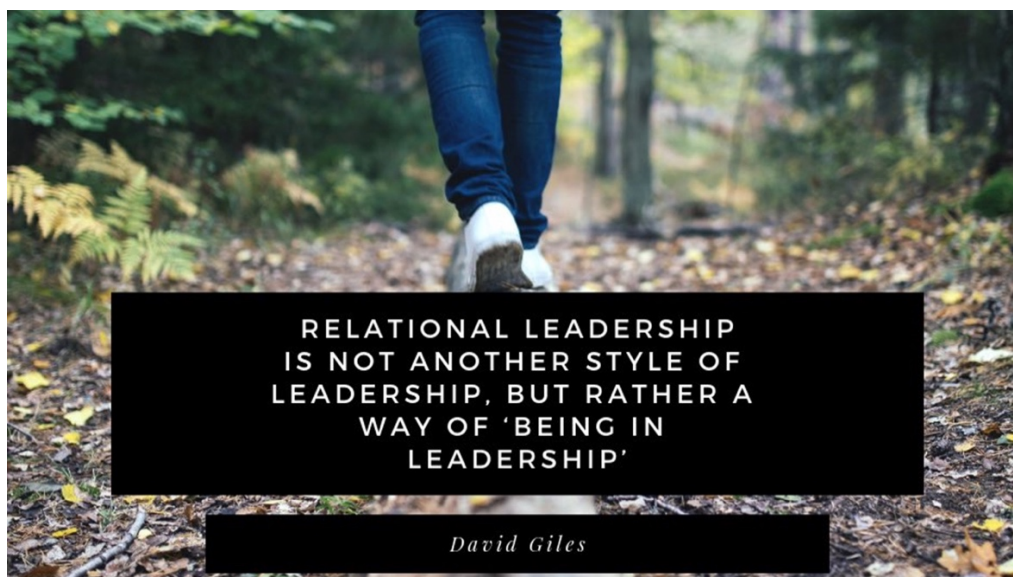




Relational Leadership in Education: A Phenomenon of Inquiry and Practice

These characteristics are evident in positional and emergent leadership, relational sensibilities; organisational culture; professional development and formation; curriculum design, pedagogy and assessment.

David Giles is currently a Professor in Education Leadership and Management at Flinders University, and Co-Director of the Flinders Leadership and Management in Education research group.

David has taught in primary and secondary schools, teacher education, educational leadership and adult education. His research interests focus on the relational nature of pedagogy, strengths-based practice, educational leadership, and organisational cultures.
